Because they were fertilized with phosphate.

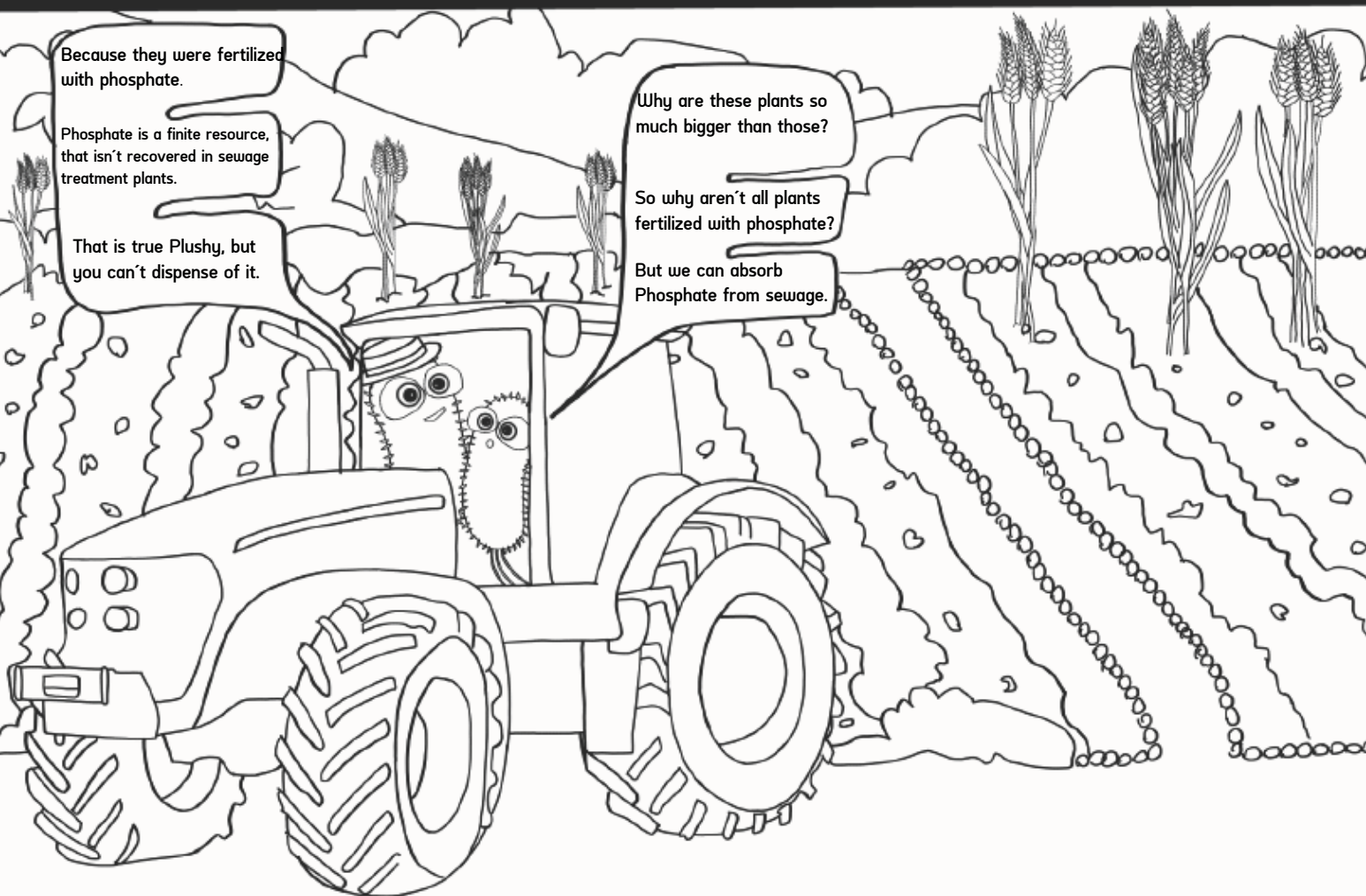
Phosphate is a finite resource, that isn't recovered in sewage treatment plants.
